He was formerly a Senior Fellow of Asian Studies at the Council on Foreign Relations. He has published in *Foreign Affairs*, *International Security*, *Current History*, *Military Review*, and a number of edited volumes. He has also co-authored several RAND monographs and is the co-editor of *China and the Developing World*. He served as a Military Intelligence Officer in the U.S. Army Reserve for fourteen years, spent more than ten years in Asia and speaks and reads Chinese and Japanese. He received his PhD in Political Science from the MIT.

FORREST E. MORGAN is a policy analyst for the RAND Corporation. A recently retired Air Force officer, he has held such jobs as commander of a space operations detachment, staff officer at Headquarters Air Force Space Command and Headquarters United States Air Force.
