Gr 9 Up--A compendium of 547 A-to-Z entries that offers broad coverage of the role of cities and suburbs in American history and culture. The signed articles vary from a few paragraphs to several pages in length, with bibliographies and cross-references included after each. The work opens with an introductory essay on urban studies and ends with a detailed general index and a list of entries by 16 thematic subjects. Black-and-white captioned illustrations are few in number but well selected. As acknowledged in the preface, the material included is an "eclectic and idiosyncratic" mix. Unlike the in-depth coverage of specific cities found in the four-volume *Cities of the United States* (Gale, 1997), the entries here relate to a diverse and multidisciplinary brew of urban phenomena, people, places, and events over a broad period of time. The information is relevant to urban places in general, not to specific locales, though some individual cities are included. There is good coverage of issues of race, ethnicity, women, and immigration. Occasionally, however, there are curious omissions: e.g., there are main entries for the engineers John and Washington Roebling but not for the Brooklyn Bridge. Cities and suburbs are dynamic organisms; this reference work successfully tackles the enormous subject of urban life.
