Greene, the United States Military Attache with the Russian Headquarters, who was in the field throughout the war and whose work is the standard authority; from Mr. Nemirovitch-Dantchenko's interesting and vivid Personal Reminiscences of General Skobeleff; from the late Valentine Baker Pasha's War in Bulgaria; and from sundry Russian narratives and reminiscences. I have to a considerable extent utilised some personal experiences of my own, and have drawn occasionally on my correspondence to the Daily News, a newspaper to which I owe what of success may have attended a career of some activity and variety.
